

Notice to Mariners: Geophysical Survey Holderness Coast - Update

1. INTRODUCTION

Mariners are advised that Orsted Hornsea Project Four Limited will be carrying out offshore geophysical surveys from 14 August 2020 (weather dependent) for the cable landing of the proposed Hornsea Project Four Offshore Wind Farm (hereafter Hornsea Four) located within the UK Sector of the North Sea, off the coast of East Yorkshire as shown in the figure within this notice.

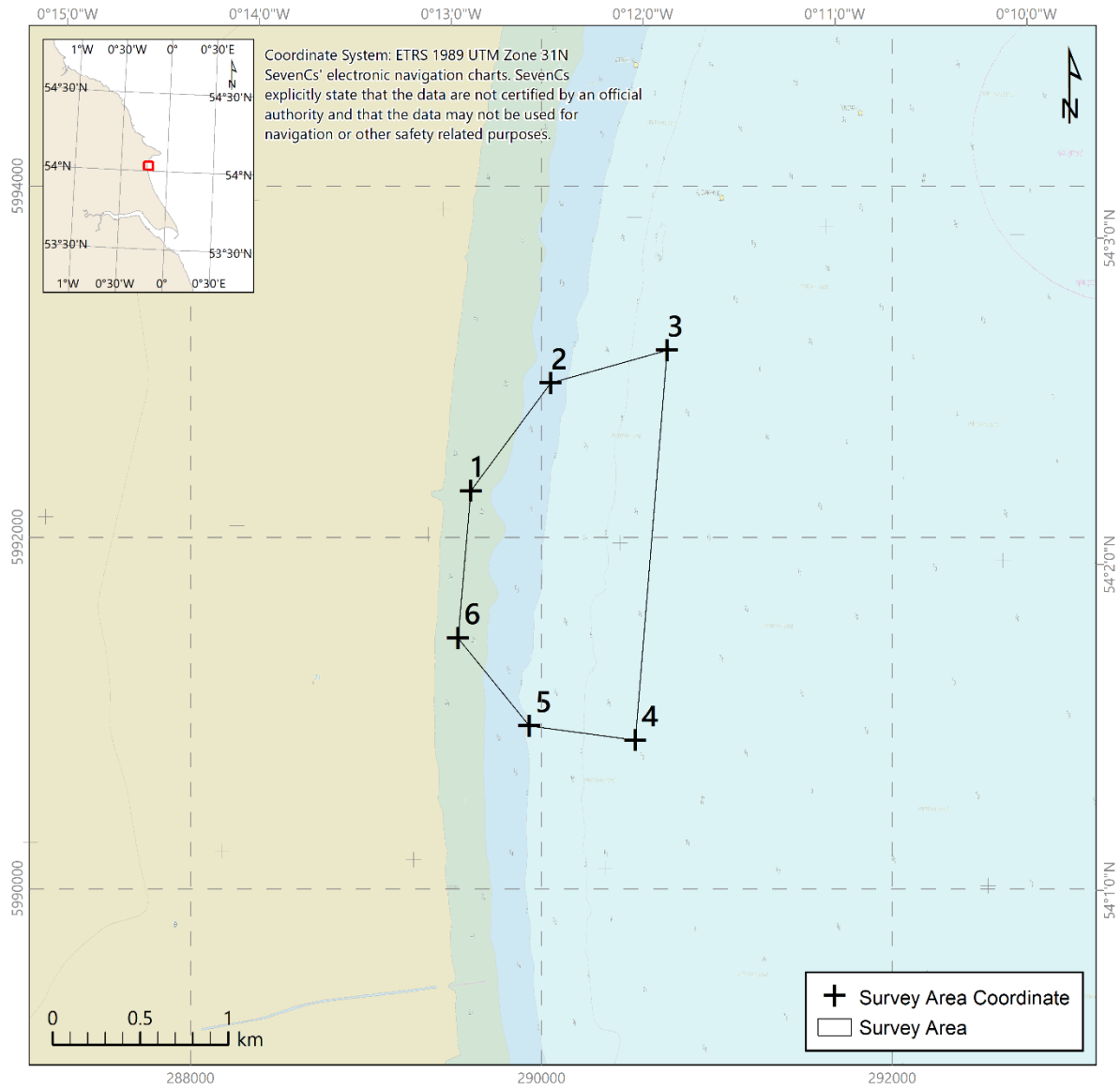

2. AREA OF OPERATIONS

Activities will take place in the Hornsea Four nearshore area. The extent of the area in which the survey will be conducted is shown in the map overleaf.

The survey vessel will operate daily to locations within the survey area at times and positions determined by tide, weather and sea conditions. The vessel will likely operate out of Scarborough.

3. SURVEY

3.1 Geophysical Survey

Please be advised that Hornsea Four will be carrying out a geophysical survey with the vessel Fugro Seeker.

The operations are planned to commence on or around 14 August 2020 and last approximately 3 weeks. The exact survey dates are dependent on weather and work progress, but the forecasted completion date as of the publication date of this notice is the end of August 2020.

The survey areas will be covered using a full geophysical survey spread including towed equipment which may be up to 400m behind the vessel. It is requested that all vessels operating within the area keep a safe distance (750m) and pass at minimum speed.

3.2 Safety

Furthermore, it is requested that anybody having knowledge of any potential objects submerged or moored on the seabed, within the survey area, that could be damaged or form a hazard to the survey vessel and its equipment advises the Project Onshore Fisheries Industry Representative of their position and nature. When surveys commence, a listening watch will be maintained on VHF Channel 12 and 16 when within the appropriate port authority area and will actively transmit an AIS signal. The survey vessels will also broadcast at regular daily intervals, vessel position, operational information and intentions.

4. IMMEDIATE CONTACTS
